

The Future Tense

- The **Future Tense** is used to show that an action will take place in the **future**. The modal verb **'will'** is added to the **infinitive**.

 **Example:**



Tomorrow **Tony** _____ sweets to share with his classmates. (**bring**)

Tomorrow **Tony** **will bring** sweets to share with his classmates. (**bring**)

Infinitive = **bring**

Future Tense = **will** + **bring** = **will bring**

Exercise 1.  Now complete the table below. An example has been done for you.

Verb to read	Verb to run	Verb to walk
I will read	I will run	I will walk
You will read	You will run	You will walk
He will read	He will run	He will walk
She will read	She will run	She will walk
It will read	It will run	It will walk
We will read	We will run	We will walk
They will read	They will run	They will walk

Exercise 2.  Write the following verbs in the **Future Tense**.

- Tonight **I will help** my mother to prepare dinner. (**help**)
- Father will clean** his car tomorrow. (**clean**)
- Next week **Tara will celebrate** her birthday. (**celebrate**)
- Soon **we will be** on holidays. (**be**)
- Our teacher will take** us to the Museum next month. (**take**)
- Next year **Fred will buy** a new bicycle. (**buy**)
- Tomorrow **my cousin will send** a letter to her best friend. (**send**)
- Our parents will attend** a meeting this afternoon. (**attend**)
