

## The Future Tense

- The **Future Tense** is used to show that an action will take place in the **future**. The modal verb **'will'** is added to the **infinitive**.

 **Example:**




Tomorrow **Tony** \_\_\_\_\_ sweets to share with his classmates. ( **bring** )

Tomorrow **Tony** **will bring** sweets to share with his classmates. ( **bring** )

Infinitive = **bring**

Future Tense = **will** + **bring** = **will bring**
