The Future Tense

The Future Tense is used to show that an action will take place in the future. The modal verb 'will' is added to the infinitive.

∠テ Example:



Tomorrow Tony _	sweets to share with his classmates. (bring
Tomorrow Tony	will bring sweets to share with his classmates. (bring)
Infinitive = bring	
Future Tense =	= <mark>will</mark> + <mark>bring</mark> = <mark>will</mark> bring
