Any...	anyone anybody	anywhere	anything
Every...	everyone everybody	everywhere	everything
No...	no one nobody	nowhere	nothing
Some...	someone somebody	somewhere	something

Indefinite pronouns are used to talk about *people, places or things* without saying exactly who, where or what they are. They are followed by singular verbs.

'any' is often used in negative statements and questions.
