1. The use of land for building shops, supermarkets and shopping centres refers to **commercial** land use.
2. The use of land to build housing estates or flats for people to live in, is known as **residential** land use.
3. A plot of land which is left without any cultivation or building and which has been abandoned and neglected by its owner is called **wasteland**
4. **Recreational** land use refers to land which has been used to build stadiums, parks, hotels and swimming pools.
These facilities have been set up in order to provide people with **leisure** activities.
5. Land which is used for the cultivation of crops and the rearing of animals is known as **agricultural** land use.
6. In Mauritius, we can travel easily and quickly from one place to another because good roads have been built all over the country. Our road network refers to **infrastructural** land use.
7. The use of land to set up factories and industrial zones is known as **industrial** land use.
8. Nowadays, agricultural land use has **decreased** in Mauritius.
This is because more land was needed for the **building** of houses, industries, roads, hotels and shopping centres.
