Revision exercises: The Present Continuous Tense (Part 3) - ANSWERS

Example: **They** **The pupils** **are** **clapping** their hands at this moment. (to clap)

1. Now **I** **am** **swimming** in the river. (to swim)
2. **You** **are** **running** in the school yard at present. (to run)
3. **He** **Jimmy** **is** **travelling** by bus at this moment. (to travel)
4. Listen! **She** **Mother** **is** **humming** a song. (to hum)
5. Now **They** **the labourers** **are** **digging** a hole in the soil. (to dig)
6. **We** **Paul and I** **are** **chatting** with our friends now. (to chat)
7. Look! **He** **The baby** **is** **rubbing** his nose. (to rub)

9. Hurry up ! **We** **are** **getting** late for school. (to get)
10. **They** **The men** **are** **cutting** wood at this moment. (to cut)

13. At present **She** **Jenny** **is** **skipping** in the yard. (to skip)
14. **You** **are** **putting** your books on the shelf now. (to put)
15. Look! **It** **The dog** **is** **wagging** its tail. (to wag)
16. **They** **My parents** **are** **shopping** at the supermarket now. (to shop)
17. **He** **The policeman** **is** **controlling** the traffic at present. (to control)
18. What is Uncle Joe doing? **He** **is** **sitting** on a bench. (to sit)
19. Wait! **It** **is** **beginning** to rain. (to begin)
20. **She** **The poor lady** **is** **begging** for some money now. (to beg)
