The Simple Present Tense (Part 1)

Remember

> In the third person singular i.e he, she and it, most verbs take 's'.

Examples:

- 1. He sings very well. (to sing)
- 2. It sleeps in its basket. (to sleep)
- 3. She eats cereals. (to eat)

Note: When the *subject* is a *noun*, replace it by the appropriate **personal pronoun**. This will help you to conjugate the verb correctly.

(He)

Example: Every year Tom _____ part in the drawing competition. (to take)

Tom can be replaced by "He", therefore we add 's' to the verb 'take'

He takes = Tom takes

Every year Tom takes part in the drawing competition. (to take)
