- (a) John likes ice-cream and chocolate.
- (b) Ben, Lily, Zara and Tom are friends.
- (c) Father and mother are going to Port- Louis.
- (d) The fish and the crocodile are swimming.
- (e) Anita and Yash are cousins.

Question 2. Join the two sentences together using “and” as in the given example.

Example: Max plays football. Max plays badminton.

Answer. : Max plays football and badminton.

- (a) Dylan is eating pizza. Dylan is eating cheese.

Dylan is eating pizza **and** cheese.

- (b) My sister likes comics books. She likes fantasy books.

My sister likes comics **and** fantasy books.

- (c) Kyle is good at maths. Kyle is good at science.

Kyle is good at maths **and** science.
