Daniel removes 72 blocks from a jar. There were originally 84 blocks in the jar. How many blocks are left in the jar?

Answer:

84 blocks - 72 blocks = 12 blocks

Billy has 95 stickers. He shares 4 with Harry. How many stickers will Billy have?

Answer:

95 stickers - 4 stickers = 91 stickers

Jason starts with 49 crayons. Joshua takes 42 away. How many crayons does Jason end with?

Answer:

49 crayons - 42 crayons = 7 crayons

Randy has 63 stickers. He loses 15. How many stickers will Randy have?

Answer:

63 stickers - 15 stickers = 48 stickers

Lawrence has 80 Skittles. He buys 6 more. How many Skittles does Lawrence have in all?

Answer:

80 Skittles + 6 Skittles = 86 Skittles
