Proper and Common nouns

Proper nouns are words to name specific items such as people, places and things.

Proper nouns always start with a capital letter.

For example

Sara is my best friend.

My dog's name is Cottons.

I live in Port-Louis.

Common nouns are words used to name nonspecific persons, places and things.

A common noun does not start with a capital letter.

Example:

My dog is barking.

The boys are playing in the swimming pool.
